

Sustainable Resource Management in South West Cameroon, Phase IV

As part of the DC programme "Sustainable Resource Management in Cameroon", the project aims at the conservation of high-value ecosystems and the sustainable improvement of the living conditions of the population through sustainable forest and wildlife management in the south-western region of Cameroon by those affected, particularly the poorer sections of the local population. The target group of the project is the population (approx. 195,000 people) living in the vicinity of the protected areas, the forest concessions and the community and village forests. Positive effects on the global commodities "biodiversity" and "climate" are of worldwide interest.
